

January Prayer Challenge.

Identify a person that you know needs salvation. Pray for them every day using the following five prayer points, taking one each day. Do this throughout January and you will have prayed through the list 6 times for that person.

1. Ask the Holy Spirit to spiritually stir the individual, to have Holy Spirit inspired dreams, a desire/interest in eternal issues.
2. Command the enemy to leave the individual alone to pursue their blood purchased cleansing and destiny.
2 Corinthians 4:4
2Corinthians 10:3-5

For the individual concerned, ask God for discernment for the main areas that need to be prayed about.

As you lift this person to God, be led by the Spirit. Romans 8:26

3. Ask God to bring other Christians across their path. Pray that they will have divine appointments and encounters with Christians.
Its probably not your job to bring about the complete salvation cycle for the individual.
Pray for other Christians to play their part. 1 Corinthians 3:6-9.
Ask God to keep judgemental and legalistic Christians from them.
4. Pray blessings into their life – Number 6:24-26.
Always speak well of the person. Speak about 'when' they become a Christian.
5. Engage in Spiritual warfare for the individual. Ask God to keep them from making decisions that lead to further sin and captivity. Ask for the Spirit to challenge them as He challenged the prodigal son. Ask God to keep them from their destructive patterns and to reveal new paths that have a destiny of life (Revelation 3:7).
Read Hosea 2, particularly verses 6-7 and 14-15, then pray these verses over the individual.
